Our classes all take place at Kensworth Village Hall, near Dunstable. This large and spacious indoor venue with its neighbouring parkland provides an excellent and safe training location. Our classes are fully registered, insured and instructed by qualified and experienced dog trainers. There are car parking and refreshment facilities. Our classes are very reasonably priced, not because they are not good, but instead because we are a charity and do not overcharge.

You will need to become a member of the trust for just £10 per year, and after that you simply pay just £3 per dog, per weekly class you come to!*

Keeping Children Safe



Around Dogs

Their love is unconditional, their looks can melt your heart, and their intelligence amazes us no end. Dogs have long been considered "man's best friend," but even the most gentlest of pooches has been known to bare his teeth. And not surprisingly, children are the usual victims. But blending a household with dogs and children is possible, and begins with teaching your children to respect the dog's fears and instincts. Teach your children to speak quietly, move slowly and always follow these simple rules when around dogs:

1. Always ask the owner before stroking a strange dog.
2. Do not stroke a dog through fences or car windows.
3. Do not go near a dog whilst they are eating, sleeping or playing with their toys.
4. Children should always be supervised by an adult when around dogs.
5. Do not touch a mummy dog whilst she is caring for her puppies.
6. It is advisable to shut the dog away in a different room whilst a child is eating.
7. Do not pull on a dog's ears, tails or legs.

All dogs have the potential to bite, no matter what breed or age they are! It is recommended that you take your dog to obedience training classes like those run by Central Bedfordshire Canine Trust.

Central Bedfordshire Canine Trust offers a free educational scheme to Schools, Brownies, Beavers and other Youth Groups in Central Bedfordshire, aimed at teaching children to be safe around dogs and how to care for them.

A qualified and CRB cleared member of our educational team will visit and deliver the scheme through fun games and activities.

On completion all children receive a certificate.
