Competition League Show Commendation & Show Champion Information

For Use From The 5th December 2011 Onwards

1. All members of Central Bedfordshire Canine Trust may take part in the Competition League and claim show commendations and Central Bedfordshire Canine Trust – Show Champion Titles.
2. Show Commendations and Central Bedfordshire Canine Trust – Show Champion Titles will be issued on receipt of the fully completed official application from the registered owner of the dog, who is also a trust member, in the case of partnerships, both owners must be members of the trust.
3. Every time your dog wins a qualifying win at a Kennel Club Licensed Show, record your wins on the form.
4. Each time your dog reaches the following points, send in your form, so we can issue your dog with the appropriate commendations:
 - a. 100 points – Bronze Show Commendation
 - b. 200 points – Silver Show Commendation
 - c. 300 points – Gold Show Commendation
5. When your dog reaches the required number of points for your breed's Stud Book Band, send in your form, so we can issue your dog with the title of Central Bedfordshire Canine Trust – Show Champion:
 - a. 500 points – Dogs In Stud Book Band A
 - b. 480 points – Dogs in Stud Book Band B
 - c. 460 points - Dogs in Stud Book Band C
 - d. 440 points – Dogs In Stud Book Band D
 - e. 420 points – Dogs In Stud Book Band E
6. Each year we have a Dog Of The Year and Kennel Of The Year, which are presented at the Annual Awards. We add up all the points won by each dog taking part, and the dog that has won the highest number of points that year, gets the title and the owner who gets the most points across all his/her dogs wins Kennel Of The Year.

To Enter For The Annual Points Trophies, Forms Must Reach Us By The 5th December Each Year.

Competition League, Show Commendation & Show Champion Points Grid

- NEW CRITERIA** You may only claim points for wins where there were three or more dogs ENTERED in the class, irrespective of absentees.
- NEW CRITERIA Veterinary Checks & Minimum Award Level – Applies To Champion Title Only**
In order to be awarded the title of Central Bedfordshire Canine Trust – Show Champion, the dog must have been awarded at least one Challenge Certificate or Best Of Breed at a Kennel Club Licensed Championship Dog Show, in the case of breeds recognised by Board Of Trustees as "High Profile" due to health and welfare issues, at least one Kennel Club Veterinary Examination must have been carried out and passed at a Championship Dog Show.
- ANY wins at shows organised by Central Bedfordshire Canine Trust can be claimed at the "Crufts" point's level.
